### Hotel Huis Ter Duin



This 5-star hotel, directly on the Noordwijk beach, has 254 rooms, excellent conference facilities and a number of restaurants. Restaurant Latour, crowned with one Michelin star, the informal restaurant La Terrasse, diverse bars and lounges. The hotel also offers a Wellness Centre and excellent running along the beach. The hotel is centrally located between Amsterdam and Den Haag and the travelling time from Schiphol airport is around 25-30 minutes, pending on traffic.

### Noordwijk



Noordwijk, in the Province of Zuid-Holland is a small village with approximately 24.000 inhabitants and with a rich history. Situated at the seaside, it is the energetic heart of the famous bulbgrowing region, with an eye-catching 12 km of fantastic sandy beaches. The village has an old friendly town centre, rugged dunes and magnificent woodlands. Moreover the cities of Amsterdam, Rotterdam, Leiden and the Hague are to be found within a 40 km radius. Noordwijk is steeped in history, the essence of which is openness to the outside world and an extensive exchange of people, goods, culture, faiths and beliefs.

### Arrival

Provided we have received your flight information, transfer from the airport to the hotel is pre-arranged for all arrivals during the event and the cost is taken care of by SKF. Please go to Meeting Point at Schiphol Airport - it is easy to locate as it is a cube pillar in red and white. There you will find your driver and our hostesses carrying SKF signs. Please notice that the transfer from airport to the hotel will take 25-30 minutes under normal traffic conditions. We kindly ask you to register on the site even if your flight details are yet not completed, you can update the site or contact us later on.

### Check-in at the hotel

Credit Cards are accepted in most hotels, shops and bigger restaurants. However, you usually must pay taxis in cash and also the smaller bars and cafés in Noordwijk do not accept cards.

Euro (€) is the currency in The Netherlands, 1 EUR is around 1.30 USD.
